Actions: Discussion with children about what they enjoy/do not enjoy about coming to school
 PSHE work around feeling safe, including NSPCC workshops and Learning council
 Discussion with children around relationships with adults: how do we know they care?
 Review our self and peer assessment practices so that all pupils are clear on how well they are doing at school.
 Work with pupils in revising the behaviour policy and discuss their perceptions of poor behaviour. What do they think good behaviour looks like?
 Share school developments and school improvements with pupils through the school learning council and through assemblies. Ask for pupil input into the school improvement plan.
 Improve the range of after school club activities to include more training for sports teams and more creative activities.
 Ensure that all pupils have the opportunity to take part in competitive sports with pupils from other schools of a similar level.
 Investigate how technology is used to enhance the curriculum across the school and share the findings with pupils. Continue to improve technology resources in order that all pupils have more opportunities to use technology across the curriculum.
