Imagine you were President of the USA. What would you do? Make a list of 10 laws that you would put in place.	Create a Native American headdress, or create a natural collage. Use natural resources and take a picture of your work.	Research a recipe that is typical of a US state. Share a copy of the recipe along with a photo of your finished creation. You could always bring in some of your cooking to share too!	Research a different Native American Tribe (not the Iroquois) and make a presentation explaining what you find out.
There have been many U.S. presidents throughout history. Write a short biography about one of them.	Create an advertisement to sell the cupboard that makes toys come to life in <i>The Indian in the Cupboard</i> . You could make a poster, write a jingle, or even film it!	Native American symbols can vary in meaning from one tribe to another and across different regions. How much can find out about this language?	Native Americans sometimes used smoke signals to communicate over long distances. Come up with a secret code to send messages. For example, it could involve hand signals or flashing lights.
