Dear parents and carers,

This week has been very productive and we are delighted to advise that following this afternoon's AGM for our PTFA we have a full committee. Thank you to all the parents who were able to attend the meeting this afternoon.

Each week, we are proud to present our reading trophy to the class with the highest percentage of children reading at home at least four times a week to an adult. Lat week one class achieved 100% of pupils achieving this which was fantastic! This week the percentages were lower across the school and we would therefore emphasize the importance of reading regularly at home to an adult and the impact this has on a child. Reading at least four times per week at home has a profound impact on a child's academic achievement, cognitive development, and emotional wellbeing. Here are some compelling statistics and findings to support this practice:

Children who read at home regularly are likely to perform 2.5 times better on reading tests than their peers who do not.

Reading four or more times per week increases vocabulary acquisition by as much as 26% more per year compared to infrequent readers.

Students who engage in regular reading are more likely to achieve higher grades across all subjects, as literacy is foundational to comprehension in math, science, and other disciplines.

A study by the Department for Education (DfE) found that children who read daily or almost daily at home achieve a reading age one year ahead of their actual age by the end of Key Stage 2.

We are delighted to announce that we raised a total of £121.00 for children in need last week so would again like to thank you for sending your children into school in their bright colours.

Today in our Collective Worship, we announced that seven children from Robin Class are becoming published authors, they were awarded their certificates today. Well done and congratulations! The children have brought home letters for their parents regarding this today.

We would like to take this opportunity to thank you all for your continued support of your child and the school. Have a wonderful weekend.


