Dear parents and carers,

We have reached the end of another week full of engaging learning experience, the teachers have written some paragraphs describing the learning which has been taking place.

Kestrel Class This week have been admiring our baby photos and looking at which exciting features we have inherited from family members. Next week, we will be looking at the nature versus nurture debate and laughing at the teacher baby photos. We spent a fun afternoon on Friday learning how to thread needles and create a very basic running stitch. Hopefully, over time this will progress into making pouches to look after our phones. We have gone dotty with learning about decimals and the children have produced some excellent persuasive writing about recycling more plastic waste and disposing of our litter correctly, therefore not endangering the wildlife in our oceans.

Robin Class In English, we have been writing a diary entry based on one of our main characters from Krindle Krax. In Science this week, we have been using Newton metres to measure the force of different objects and investigations with this equipment. In RE, we have been learning about how Jewish people inspire others and Mitzvah Day and what we could do to celebrate that day. In Maths, Y3 are learning about lengths and perimeter with adding and subtracting length. Y4s are learning about multiplication and division and dividing with remainders. In History, we completed a debate about whether or not a tribe should invade the Romans. We have also enjoyed forest school this week and made jewellery using conkers.

Badger Class In our Maths learning we have been exploring money and the different coins and notes. We have also been reading and writing the numbers up to 20. We have looked at different materials in Science and the properties of these materials. Next week, we will be investigating which materials are waterproof. We created our own comic strips based on the story of Traction Man in English and wrote about what we think happens next in the story. In our History learning, we have learnt about games from the past, including Ancient Egypt and even got the play the game Senet. Finally, we finished making our roly poly toys and got to test them out.
